In this regard, it is informed that the given transfer was effected vide Reg. No. MOEAF/R/2018/90050 dated 31.05.2018 to M/o External Affairs.
- 6. Based on the reasons given above, no further action is called for on your appeal and the same is accordingly disposed off.
